




### **BRITAIN, BY MONARCH & SKETCH** F Lestar Martin

This book is unique as it presents a concise history of Great Britain as an island kingdom from the reigns of William I in 1066 to that of Queen Elizabeth II in the present century. The preface contains an overview of the hereditary composition of the monarchy, the coronation portrait of Queen Elizabeth II, and a listing of the monarchs from 1066 to the present. The introduction contains, a brief history of the four countries -- England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales -- and how they came to be united as the Kingdom of Great Britain. The monarchy is divided into ten houses, or dynasties. A two--fold page layout describes each dynasty from the Normans to the Windsors. Each layout contains: a listing of individual monarchs and dates of reigns; depiction of coins with monarch images; listing of historical events occurring in each reign with marriage information; and two-colour sketches with narrative description of architectural buildings of the period. Thus, there is a 1000 year history of the evolution of architecture from defensive to domestic usage.

### **CANADA'S CONSTITUTIONAL MONARCHY** Nathan Tidridge

Canadians enjoy one of the most stable forms of government on the planet, but there is a crisis in our understanding of the role the Crown plays in that government. Media often refer to the governor general as the Canadian head of state, & the queen is frequently misidentified in Canada as only the British monarch, yet she has been queen of Canada since 1952. Even government publications routinely cast the Crown as merely a symbolic institution with no impact on the daily lives of Canadians -- this is simply not true. Errors such as these are echoed in school textbooks & curriculum outlines. This book has been written to counter the misinformation given to Canadians, reintroducing them to a rich institution integral to our ideals of democracy & parliamentary government. Nathan Tidridge presents the Canadian Crown as a colourful & unique institution at the very heart of our Confederation, exploring its history from its beginnings in 16th-century New France, as well as its modern relationships with First Nations, Honours, Heraldry, & the day-to-day life of the country.






**MAJESTY IN CANADA: Essays on the Role of Royalty** Edited by Colin Coates




**NOW YOU KNOW ROYALTY** Doug Lennox


**ON HER MAJESTY'S SERVICE: Royal Honours & Recognitions in Canada**








**ROYAL BOOK OF LISTS: An Irreverent Romp through British Royal History** Matt Richardson


**ROYAL TOURS 1786-2010: Home to Canada** Arthur Bousfield, Garry Toffoli


